It would be fair to say that this has been a busy few weeks! Please read on to find out about just some of what we've been up to and some important news about the new term in 2018!



# Staffing Update

I hope that you have received the letter, sent by eSchools, informing you of the changes to our leadership team. Just in case you haven't, please note the following:

I am delighted to be able to tell you that Clare Dimishky returned from Maternity Leave on Wednesday this week. I know that you will join me in warmly welcoming her back; she has been much missed. Clare will work for 3 days each week, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. She will have a slightly different title: Deputy Head Teacher, with responsibility for Teaching and Learning. Clare's responsibilities will be similar to those that she had before her Maternity Leave and to those that Caroline Day has so capably fulfilled in her absence.

I am equally delighted to tell you that Caroline Day has been appointed to a new position as Deputy Head Teacher, with responsibility for Inclusion. Caroline will also work for 3 days, on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday. Caroline's role will be to lead the provision for different groups of learners within the school. This will include those with additional needs (including children within the Hearing Impaired Department), those who speak English as an additional language, those who receive the pupil premium and gifted and talented learners.

Both Deputy Head Teachers will continue to have a role in the pastoral care of our pupils and in implementation of our behaviour management procedures.

#### **Emergency Closure Procedure**

Having had a couple of emergency closure days already this winter, it would seem prudent to remind you of what will happen should bad weather, or any other emergency, require the school to close. If it is deemed necessary to close the school a text message/email will automatically be sent to the main, designated contact which is on file for each child using eSchools. The system will only send one message to families with more than once child at our school. For the system to work:

\*The emergency telephone number and email address which we have on file for you must be correct! If you got a new phone for Christmas ensure that you have updated our contact details.

\*Your mobile phone must be switched on and have service.

\*Your phone must be capable of receiving text messages or emails. Not every family has provided us with a mobile phone number and the text service will not routinely work with land lines.

We have been using eSchools for some time now and most parents report that it works effectively. If it did not work for you this week then now would be a good time to resolve the issue. Please contact Karen Bennet in our office if you require help with your password or setup.

In addition to sending an eSchools message, we are also required to inform Bucks County Council of any closure. They publish the information on the COUNTY website at <u>www.buckscc.gov.uk</u>.

Where possible, we will make decisions about closure as early as possible in order to give you all as much notice as we can. Feedback about the recent closures was that this was appreciated by parents and staff. Should it be necessary to close once the school day has started then the same procedures will be implemented. This happened 7 years ago and most pupils were collected relatively quickly.

#### Hot Meals – special menu

Although ALL pupils in Reception, Yr1 and Yr 2 classes are entitled to a FREE hot meal each day, the school is actually charged for each of these meals. However the government provide the school with a grant which is designed to offset this cost. The grant is based on how many pupils actually eat a meal on one particular day each term. The count day next term is on **Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> January**. We want to encourage as many pupils as possible to eat a FREE hot meal on this day, so our grant is as large as possible! To encourage this, our cooks will be preparing a special menu which includes some of our pupils' favourite foods. If your child is in Reception, Yr1 or Yr2, please help us to maximise our grant by ordering a FREE meal for your child on this day. The deadline for ordering this meal is THURSDAY 11<sup>TH</sup> JANUARY.

#### **Christmas Events**

We started our celebrations with the PTA Christmas Bazaar. Although not as well attended as similar events in the past, I am delighted to be able to tell you that in the region of £1800 was raised. As usual, Santa was helped by an enthusiastic group of Elves shown in all their glory below.

## Admissions for Next Year

Parents with children who will join a Reception class in September 2018 need to formally apply for a place at their chosen school before 3pm on 15th January 2018. This applies to ALL children who were born between 1.09.2013 and 31.08.2014 and will include EVERY child who attends our Nursery. Most of these children will currently be only three years old and it is very important that if you know anyone with a child of this age you let them know of the January deadline. Applying for a Reception class place is a totally separate process than applying for a Nursery place because children in Nurseries have no automatic right to transfer into Reception classes - even if they are located at the same school. ## **Nursery Spaces**

We currently still have a few spaces in our Nursery for up to 30 hours per week. In September 2017 the government doubled the amount of FREE nursery provision from 15 hours per week to 30 hours per week. If you know of a family who are looking for either 15 hours of nursery provision in January, or who need up to 30 hours per week (this could be extended even more by making use of Highworth's Breakfast club and /or After school club) please ask them to contact us.
