Parking is once again becoming an issue with some of you choosing to put others at risk from dangerous choices. Please see these comments from one of our neighbours:

Whilst I appreciate that living so close to a school there will be points in the day when the street is busier than usual and that parents need to park to drop off or collect. As a parent myself, I have no issue with this. HOWEVER, I do have an issue with parents parking on my private property or in places that make it dangerous to turn in or out of Kingswood Place. For example, a white van parked on my grass verge this afternoon (the road wasn't busy at that time so it was just total lack of respect vs necessity) which has left an unsightly muddy tyre imprint in the grass. It will take several months to grow back at this time of year. In addition, it is once again becoming frequent that parents are illegally parked on the corner.

I don't think it is unreasonable to expect the parents of the children at your school to respect the residents' private property or the safety of the road that they are parking in.
