Super Science! Design a bright, colourful and informative poster to give children a clear message about how to stay safe around electricity. For example: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Never use wet hands around electrical sockets and appliances- Place wires and leads in a safe place- Do not leave electrical appliances and devices on or when you are out of the house. Write about somewhere you have visited in the United Kingdom. Provide the following information: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Where you went?- When you went?- Why did you go?- What physical (natural) and human (man-made) features did you see? <i>Challenge: Can you draw a map to show these features or to show where you place is in the United Kingdom?</i>	
Perfect Poetry! Find a poem that you like and write it up in neat either in your homework or on a plain piece of paper. Try to include neat, joined handwriting and if you would like to draw any images to go with it, we would love to see them. Please also include a title and the name of poet. <i>Challenge: Practise performing your poem to an audience, remembering to speak slowly and clearly.</i>		Radical Recount! Write a recount to tell us about as much information as you can about: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Your summer holiday- Your favourite day of the summer holidays- A day out- Your first day in Year 4 <i>Challenge: Rewrite a part of your recount to make improvement e.g. add in more descriptive vocabulary</i>	
Computing! Our computing unit is Word Processing. Could you type up one of your pieces of writing to practise your skills? <i>Challenge: Format your text – change the font, size and colour!</i>	Fantastic Friends! Create a poster to describe how you can be great friend. Make it colourful and include at least one picture. We would love to display some in our classrooms! <i>Challenge: Write about a time where you have been a kind friend to someone.</i>	Clever Coiling! Apply the techniques that you have learned in Art to produce another piece of coiling artwork. <i>Challenge: Imagine you are a critic and write a review of your artwork.</i>
