<p>Literacy/Communication Play follow my leader with your family. One person chose a body percussion, e.g. patting knees, clapping hands, clicking fingers. The rest of the family copy the movement/sound. Each person takes it in turn to be the leader.</p>	<p>Mathematical Development Can you count how many footsteps to your front door? How many footsteps to the kitchen?</p>	<p>Knowledge and Understanding of the World Can you make a pair of binoculars using two toilet or kitchen roll tubes? What can you see? Draw a picture of what you can see?</p>
<p>Physical Can you put on your own socks and shoes today?</p>	<p>Personal and Social Can you help your family with sorting and putting away your clean washing/clothes?</p>	<p>Creative Look in the garden or park at the trees, bricks, pavements. Can you do a rubbing onto paper using paper and crayons to show their pattern and prints.</p>
