**Computing – Instructions**

You have been learning about algorithms. They are a set of instructions used to tell a computer program what to do. Can you order the instructions for building this tower to show which order they should go in? If you have bricks at home, you could try it.

Stick a yellow brick on top of the red brick.

Stick a toy man on top.

Start with a red brick.

Repeat the pattern again and stick it on top.

Stick a blue brick on top

Stick on another brick of the same colour.



**Geography**

Go on a local area walk and identify as many different types of mode of transport as you can.


Can you draw a map with the different modes of transport you saw on your travels?

**Shape - Potato Printing**

**Super Science**

See how many different materials you can find around your house – plastic spoon, metal spoon, cork, pebble, paper, sponge, flannel and investigate to see if they sink or float. You will need a bowl of water – ask an adult to help.
