Objectives in Spending Sports Funding

Raising attainment, achievement and enjoyment of pupils in sport through:

i) Increasing Sports provision during the lunch hour

ii) Increasing sporting clubs (both before, during and after school), including taking part in competitive sport against other schools

iii) Increasing the number of children who can swim 25m by the end of Year 6

Providing Positive Play during lunchtimes to encourage active games (all year)	33% of grant
Coaches for each year group to attend sporting events throughout the year	11% of grant
