

Home School Agreement 2019-2020

As a pupil at Highworth I will:

- Follow the school rules and values.
- Be sensible and kind to others and look after everyone.
- Try hard to do my best work and to ask for help when I need it.
- Do home learning, as requested by my teacher.
- Respect other people; their views, beliefs and feelings, listen and not interrupt.
- Respect other people's property, the school and the wider environment.
- Follow our School's Internet agreement at school or if using school e-mail from home.
- Never bring a mobile phone or Internet enabled device into school.
- Wear my school uniform with pride.

As a family we will:

- Ensure that our child attends school regularly, wearing the school uniform and suitably equipped for the day.
- Ensure our child arrives at school punctually, and is collected promptly at the end of the day.
- Not take our child out of school during term time, always ring on the day of absence and ensure that we write a prompt letter of explanation for absences from school.
- Actively support our child's studies both at home and, when possible, by attending class assemblies, etc.
- Attend consultation meetings and other meetings concerning our child's education.
- Support the school's policies and ethos.
- Ensure our child completes any home learning, as requested by their teacher.
- Ensure that our child follows the code laid out in the pupil's School's Internet Agreement if using school e-mail from home.
- Ensure photographs taken in school are not uploaded onto the internet (e.g. on Facebook) without the permission of everyone in the photograph, or the parents of every child.
- Make every effort to walk to school when possible and park responsibly if we have to use a car.
- Ensure that our child never brings a mobile phone or Internet enabled device into school.

At Highworth we will:

- Care for your child's safety and happiness and inform you of any problems he/she may have.
- Listen to your child.
- Follow our Child Protection Policy to ensure that your child is kept safe.
- Value your child, praise his/her efforts and qualities and encourage him/her to do his/her best at all times.
- Provide a high quality education that meets all the requirements of the National Curriculum.
- Encourage all children to take care of each other and their surroundings.
- Keep you informed of your child's progress through regular consultation meetings and an annual school report.
- Maintain good communications with all parents and carers by means of eSchools, letters, newsletters and website.
- Follow the 'Home Learning Policy'.
