The Internet is a valuable source of information and an important way to send messages. Its importance will increase over the next few years. We want pupils at Highworth to benefit from using the Internet but we also want them to use it safely. All school computers can only access the Internet using a "filtered" service which provides a very high level of protection. The code below supplements this and is recommended for use in all Buckinghamshire schools but we have written it using words which most primary school children will understand.

	© I will always treat all electronic equipment (including the computers and iPads) with care and respect.
	© I will never send anyone my picture without permission from my teacher or parents.
	© I will never give my password to anyone, not even my best friend.
	© I will only use the Internet when I am with a teacher or adult.
	© When using the Internet, I will follow the instruction given to me by my teacher or adult.
	© I will tell my teacher or an adult straight away if I find something unpleasant.
	© I will never try to find bad words or pictures, or mean or unkind material on purpose.
	My files will be checked by my teacher to make sure I am keeping to the rules.
	© I will only send polite e-mail messages to the people I know at the addresses my teachers give me.
	© I will ask my teacher, or an adult, to check my e-mail messages before I send them.
	© I will not give out my address or phone number, or arrange to meet anyone, over the Internet.
	© I will not download software from the Internet.
	© I will log off the computer when I have finished using it.
	© I know that the information on the Internet may not always be true and I may need to check it.
