Home Learning

Here are some suggested activities you could complete as a family. They are linked to our Early Years Foundation Stage Curriculum and will support your child in developing their skills and knowledge across the six areas of learning. Have fun!

Look closely for signs of spring. What do you notice? Can you name any spring flowers? Daffodil? Primrose? Tulip?	Find out about baby animals on the farm. What is a baby cow called? A sheep? A goat?	Draw a picture of a room in your home. Can you add labels to it?
Keep a diary of the weather for a week. Draw pictures to show what the weather was like.	Make a sandwich for yourself or a member of your family. Can you cut it in half? Can you cut it into quarters?	Find 3 toys or objects. Can you put them in order from the lightest to the heaviest?
Practice writing numbers from 0 to 20.	Draw a picture of something you did at the weekend. Write a sentence about it.	How many times can you catch a ball in one minute? How many jumps or hops can you do in a minute? Ask an adult to time you. Who can do the most in your family?
Use boxes, tubs and pots from the recycling to make a model. What will you make?	Talk about 2D shapes. Can you describe a square? A triangle? A rectangle? A circle? Do you know any other shapes? Look out for shapes around you.	Rhyme challenge: Write a list of words that rhyme with 'cat'. Choose another word – 'dog, 'hen'.
