<b>Super Science!</b>  Research the life of Sir Isaac Newton. Produce a fact file of what you find out and draw a picture of him.  You could produce a PowerPoint if you prefer.	<b>Hypnotic History</b>  Find out what life was like in Ancient Egypt.  You could research: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Tutunkhamun.</li><li>- Howard Carter and his discovery of Tut’s tomb.</li><li>- The mummification process.</li><li>- What was a ‘shabti’?</li></ul>	
<b>Wonderful Words</b>  Look at the Year 5 & 6 Words List. Choose 4 or 5 words to practise at a time. <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. If you’re not sure of the meaning of a word, look up the definition in a dictionary.</li><li>2. Learn the correct spelling by using: Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check.</li><li>3. Write a sentence which includes the word to show that you understand its meaning.</li><li>4. Challenge yourself to include an adjective or an adverbial in your sentence.</li></ul>		
<b>Super Story!</b>  Write a story as if you are a child living in Ancient Egypt.  Think carefully about the: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Characters</li><li>- Setting</li><li>- Problem</li><li>- Solution/Ending</li></ul> <i>Remember to use a joined handwriting style.</i>	<b>Anti-Bullying Week!</b>  This year, Anti-bullying Week is from the 12 <sup>th</sup> to the 16 <sup>th</sup> of November.
