

### Year 3 Home Learning - 1<sup>st</sup> Half of the Spring Term

<p><b>Perfect Poetry!</b></p> <p>We are working on learning poems by heart.</p> <p>Please find a poem that you like – it should be at least six lines long. Learn it by heart. Practise performing it at home in a loud voice with expression.</p> <p><i>Challenge: Can you make up actions to go with the poem?</i></p>	<p><b>Times Tables!</b></p> <p>Choose a times table that you need to learn and create a song, rhyme or chant that will help you to remember it.</p> <p>Present the lyrics any way that you like!</p>	<p><b>Geography Interview!</b></p> <p>Interview somebody who has travelled to any of the following physical landmarks in the UK:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- a mountain</li> <li>- a river</li> <li>- a coastal area e.g. beach, cliff, salt marsh, estuary.</li> </ul> <p>Present your findings in any way that you like. For example, a poster, interview script, paragraph of writing.</p>
<p><b>Design a healthy plate!</b></p> <p>We would like you to design a healthy plate that includes a balance of carbohydrates, protein, and fruits and vegetables. Record what ingredients you would include. You might even want to make it at home and photograph it!</p> <p><i>Challenge: Design a healthy menu.</i></p>	<p><b>Tardis Trip!</b></p> <p>Imagine Doctor Who has appeared in your living room with this Tardis.</p> <p>Research an area of the world that you would like him to take you to. What can you find out about his place?</p> <p>Present your findings in any way that you like. For example, a poster, piece of writing, a letter home or information text.</p>	<p><b>Super Skeletons!</b></p> <p>Research one of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- the human skeleton</li> <li>- exoskeletons</li> <li>- vertebrates</li> <li>- invertebrates</li> </ul> <p>Decide on a suitable way to present your findings. For example, a poster, illustrations, fact sheet, leaflet.</p> <p><i>Challenge: Make sure all scientific vocabulary is spelt correctly.</i></p>
<p><b>Menu madness!</b></p> <p>Find a takeaway menu and select food to feed a party of four people. You can choose a budget of £ 10, £15 or £25. You may choose to use money to help you work it out.</p> <p>Present your choices and working out in a clear and organised way.</p> <p><i>Challenge: Spend the exact budget. You may need to try out different combinations of dishes!</i></p>	<p><b>Magical Myths!</b></p> <p>Design your own mythical creature or hero/heroine.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Draw and label an illustration of your character</li> <li>- Give them a name</li> <li>- Describe what they look like</li> <li>- Describe their character</li> </ul> <p><i>Challenge: Write a short story that includes your character.</i></p>	<p><b>Work of Art!</b></p> <p>Look at some paintings by a famous artist and choose one of their works to recreate in your own style. You may want to sketch, sketch and colour, collage, paint, watercolour.</p> <p><i>Challenge: Research the artist and present your findings.</i></p>
