Super Science Design a bright, colourful and informative poster to give children a clear message about how to keep your teeth healthy. Draw a picture of a Roman Soldier and label his armour and weapons. Challenge: Compare a Roman soldier to a modern-day soldier.
Maths: Number bond Recap number bonds up to 10 and 20 and learn the number bonds to 100. Terrific Times Tables Choose a times table that you need to learn and create a poster showing the times table in writing and pictures. If you are confident with your timetables, choose a time limit and see how many questions you can answer in that given time. We would love to display some in our classrooms! <i>Challenge: Write about a time where you have been a kind friend to someone.</i>	Sketching Apply the techniques that you have learned in Art to produce a sketch of any object at home that you find interesting. Before sketching, carefully observe how the light falls on the object. <i>Challenge: Imagine you are a critic and write a review of your artwork.</i>
