Personal Social and Emotional	DM Making Relationships 30-50mnths Can play in a group, extending and elaborating play ideas. Building on a role play activity based on the story of 'Goldilocks and the 3 Bears' Support the children with working together in the role play area. Goldilocks went into the 3 Bears House without being invited. What could she do instead? Discuss the choices and actions of the characters. For example, Goldilocks went into a stranger's house. Was that a good idea? Why not? Should she have gone into someone's house without their permission? Talk about the importance of saying sorry. Discuss how the bears felt/reacted to what Goldilocks did. Why? How would you feel? What do you think Goldilocks should say to the three Bears & why? Play a listening game where one child is blindfolded in the middle of a circle. The children in the circle take it in turns to say, "Who's been eating my porridge?" in appropriate squeaky or gruff voice. The blindfolded child guesses who was speaking/where in room child was.

Play a listening and attention game with the children. Place a number of items from the Goldilocks story on a tray and cover with a blanket example bowls, for spoons, 3 different sizes of teddy bear. Ask the children to guess how many are there, then double check by counting. Remove one of the objects. Can they say which one has been removed?

Encourage the children to use large sheets of paper to make maps of the woods, showing the Three Bears' House and a path for Goldilocks to follow. These could be used with a Bee-Bot and these Goldilocks Bee-Bot Jackets. Children could also use this Bee-Bot Woodland Mat to explore programming and how to reach the Three Bears' House.
