Dear Parents and Carers

With the return of some wintery weather, it seems sensible to remind you of procedures in the event of school closure due to snow. David Thomas (Chair of Governors) and I only make the decision to close if we know that we will be unable to keep your children safe if the school opens. This may be because of site safety or because we cannot meet minimum supervision requirements because staff have been unable to get here. We will always try to make the decision to close as early as we can to give you as much time as possible to make alternative arrangements. School closure will be communicated first using eSchools. The closure will also be listed on the Bucks County Council Website. Use this link: https://closures.buckscc.gov.uk/Search.aspx. In the event that we need to close during the school day, a message will be sent using eSchools.

Now that has been said, let's hope we don't have any snow and this information is not needed!

A polite reminder that you must tell us in advance if you have arranged for another adult to collect your child at the end of the day. In order to keep your children safe, if we have not heard from you in advance, we will not hand children over to other adults before phoning to check with you. I appreciate that this may cause inconvenience, but know that you will understand that we have a duty to safeguard all pupils.

Please see below an important message regarding Crossing Patrollers across Bucks. Your respect for the difficult job that John does each day would be appreciated.
