Dear Parents and Carers

Our termly meeting of the Full Governing Body took place this week, during which we said goodbye to 3 of our highly committed and long standing governors: Rafiq Raja was instrumental in the creation of our school more than 25 years ago and has remained a highly respected governor ever since; Tony Green and Mike Ferguson first became involved with Highworth as parents of pupils more than 20 years ago and have given generously of their time as governors ever since. I'd like to express our thanks and appreciation for all that they have each done to support the school over so many years.

A number of parents have expressed to me their concerns about the safety of some of our older pupils when unsupervised at the end of the school day. A group of children have been congregating on the green opposite the school site and have been engaging in some risky play. Please, for the sake of the safety of your own children, and for that of others using this access route, ensure that you know what your child is doing and where they are. As you know, once children have been dismissed from class, the responsibility for their safety becomes yours.

It is so lovely to see families being helped to safely cross Totteridge Lane by our Crossing Patroller (at last!). Mr Ryan has asked me to let you know that in order to ensure your safety, it is important that you wait on the pavement until he has walked in to the road and stopped the traffic. Please do not immediately follow him as this could put you and your children at risk.

Wearing Seatbelts

We are going to be reminding all children next week about the importance of wearing a seatbelt to keep themselves safe in the car. We would very much appreciate your support in this. Please see the below guidance, which can be found at <u>https://www.gov.uk/seat-belts-law</u>.

You must wear a seat belt if one is fitted in the seat you're using.

You're also only allowed 1 person in each seat fitted with a seat belt.

You can be fined up to £500 if you don't wear a seat belt when you're supposed to. <u>Children</u>

You must make sure that any children in the vehicle you're driving are:

- in the <u>correct car seat</u> for their height or weight until they reach 135 centimetres tall or their 12th birthday, whichever is first
- wearing a seat belt if they're 12 or 13 years old, or younger and over 135cm tall

You can be fined up to £500 if a child under 14 isn't in the correct car seat or wearing a seat belt while you're driving.

We appreciate that the school run can be a hectic one, but please ensure that you follow the above guidance at all times to keep you and your families safe.
